## Personal Bible Reading Resources

As I explore beyond the usual church, so the call comes to each of us: "Take up and read." Take up and read." The reading plans and other resources provided here have been designed to help you become regular in your regular personal Bible reading.

### Reading Plans

- **ABC 2013 Bible-Reading Bookmarks.** These bookmarks are based on The Christian's Journey Reading Plan by Matthew. The plan guides you through the Bible in one year with the Old Testament and New Testament readings each day. The plan includes between five and six activities each week.
- **IBC 2013 Bible-Reading Bookmarks.** These bookmarks contain the same plan as the Christian's Journey, but in a different format. The bookmarks help you track the spirit in your own Bible as you study each week.
- **2100 Challenges.** This plan leaves the reader through 100 key Scripture passages at the reader's pace. There are 100 2100 Challenge Readings and 10 New Testament readings.

### Daily Devotional Guides

- **Open Windows.** This quarterly subscription to a daily devotional passage, a daily plan for reading the Bible through in a one- or two-day devotional reading, great devotion, and a daily morning prayer guide.
- **Tabletalk.** Tabletalk is a monthly devotional magazine that includes daily devotional readings, a through-the-Bible-in-a-year reading plan, and weekly thought-provoking articles. (Available at <http://www.tabletalk.com>)
- **The Daily Reading Bible.** Each volume has approximately 100 selected readings, and each reading focuses on a particular passage of Scripture in addition to the full text of the Scripture passage for that day's reading. The readings also include questions, "points to ponder," and prayer points. (Available at <http://www.dailyreading.com>)
- **Explore.** This quarterly subscription includes daily Bible readings, devotional commentary, and reflection questions. It also includes a through-the-Bible-in-a-year reading plan. Also available as an app for your iPhone and/or tablet. (Available at <http://www.thegospelcoalition.com>)

### Memorization Aids for Adults

- **ABC 2013 Weekly Memorization Bookmarks.** A bookmark with weekly passage references for memorization. The reverse side of the card offers a suggested memorization strategy.
- **ABC 2013 Monthly Memorization Cards.** A card with monthly passage references for memorization. The reverse side of the card offers a suggested memorization strategy.
- **An Approach to Extended Memorization of Scripture.** This booklet, written by Andrew Davis of First Baptist Church in Durham, NC, provides a strategy for memorizing lengthy passages of Scripture, up to six verses long. The booklet also includes reflections on the value of memorizing Scripture and the advantages of memorizing books of the Bible. (Free, hard copies are available at [BC](http://BC).)

### Memorization Aids for Children (and adults too!)

- **Start and Grow Memory Books.** This three-book set provides a systematic structure for parents to lead their children in the memorization of Scripture. The books are for an opportunity to learn, form, and habit and develop confidence in the memorization. The books are divided to ages: 2 years through 4½ years, 5½ years through 8½ years, and 9½ years through 12½ years. (Available at <http://www.thegospelcoalition.com>)
- **How to Teach Bible Verses to Toddlers and Preschoolers.** This short document has some good ideas for helping young children store up God's Word.

## Family Worship Resources

Parents frequently believe that God has given you the responsibility to bring up your children in the discipline and instruction of the Lord (Eph 6:4). This type of child reading can be done any age, any time, or anywhere. Here are some helpful concepts, new methods of devotionals that have found great profit in a regular time of family worship. Check out these resources for ideas as well as step-by-step guides for family worship.

### Family Devotional Guides

- **Support Kids Family Worship Guide.** This guide, prepared by the children's ministry of Baptist Church in Louisville, KY, contains suggestions on what to consider and your family worship story with devotional resources. The resources are divided by age (younger through age 10).
- **Table Talk for Families.** This book provides approximately 100 short devotionals that guide a family in their reading, discussing, and praying about a short passage of Scripture. The devotions can be adapted for families with children ages 4 to 12. The guides also include a "How to Use Table Talk" section with a variety of suggestions for using the devotionals as a launch pad for other family activities or studies. The passages and devotions are correlated with the readings in the new devotional set "Personal Bible Reading," for parents who would like to link family time with their children's personal reading. (Available at <http://www.thegospelcoalition.com>)
- **Long Story Short (Old Testament).** This book provides 78 sets of devotionals that walk families through the Old Testament and point to Jesus at every step. Each set of devotionals focuses on a key story from the Old Testament over a 5-day plan, and the devotional for each day is designed to be completed in only 10 minutes. The book includes suggestions for adapting the devotionals lessons on the age of your children and can be used with children from preschool through high school. (Available at <http://www.thegospelcoalition.com>)
- **Old Story Short (New Testament).** This volume follows the same format as Long Story Short (see above) with the exception that the 78 sets of devotionals are drawn from key parts of the New Testament. (See Long Story Short.) Also includes recommendations for adaptation based on children's ages. (Available at <http://www.thegospelcoalition.com>)

### Children's Story Bibles

- **The Big Picture Story Bible.** This story Bible is great for younger and older preschoolers (and their parents too). The book contains 10 readings (7 from the OT and 3 from the NT) and will help introduce children to some of the most prominent stories in the Bible in a way that's

## One-to-One and Small Group Study Resources

There is tremendous benefit to regular personal Bible reading. There is also great benefit to reading and studying God's Word with one or more fellow believers. Paul encouraged the saints at Ephesus "... to meet one of you apart the night with his neighbor, to see how you are doing and to help one another every day, as long as it is called 'today.' The name of our day may be indicated by the words 'today' or 'this day.' These resources offer opportunities for us to spend God's Word with grace for one another as we read and study together.

### One-to-One Resources and Materials

- **One-to-One Bible Reading.** The guides for this book are not intended as a simple guide for every Christian. The book is just one of a short, daily-based guide to reading Scripture one-to-one with another person. The every Christian can get 100 passages. The source provides six different methods for reading and discussing Scripture with someone else, and it includes suggested plans for a short program of reading. - **Devotions on Prayer and Bible Reading.** The name speaks for itself, but don't let that stop you! The short articles offer additional thoughts and encouragement related to one-to-one Bible reading.

# Bible Reading Brochures

**Four-Part Bible Reading Plan**

This plan, developed from *Discipleship Journal*, segments the whole Bible into 330 daily readings. This plan offers special features that will aid you in your journey through the Bible:

- By reading from four separate places in the Scriptures every day, you should be able to grasp better the unity of the Scriptures, as well as enjoy the variety of four different viewpoints.
- You can begin at any point during the year.
- To prevent the frustration of falling behind, which most of us tend to do when following a Bible reading plan, each month of this plan gives you only 25 readings. Since you'll have several "free days" each month, you could set aside Sundays either not to read at all, to catch up on any reading you may have missed in the past week, or to meditate on a particular passage from the previous week's readings.
- If you finish the month's readings early, you could use the final days of the month to study the passages that challenged or intrigued you.
- If reading through the entire Bible in one year seems as too large a task, you can alter the plan to meet your needs. For example, you could read the gospels and the wisdom books this year, and the other two categories next year.

In the year ahead, ask God each day to speak directly to you from the Scripture portions you read. Be expectant, and let your continual exposure to God's Word reshape your attitudes and behavior as you gain a better understanding of every part of His written testimony to us.

**How to Use This Guide:**

**Step 1:** Get a Bible that you can highlight and write your study notes in.

**Step 2:** Read the indicated verses for each day. Example: On January 1, read Genesis 1-2, Psalm 1, Matthew 1:1-17, and Acts 1:1-11.

**Step 3:** Check the boxed words each passage when you have completed the reading. Repeat this process daily until you read the entire Bible.

# Bible Reading Bookmarks

**Four-Part Bible Reading Plan Bookmarks**

The plan, developed by Dr. Philip Darvall, segments the whole Bible into 400 daily readings. Start at any time of the year. Spend 15 to 20 minutes a day and read the Bible from cover to cover! (The plan includes Bible maps as well as the time that would best fit you. This plan has a number of benefits:

- By reading four equal-size plans in the Scriptures every day, you should be able to finish going the whole Bible in 400 days, with an extra day for each of the four different categories.
- Each month of this plan gives you only 25 readings. Use the key for Scripture memorization or for each day's reading.
- If reading through the entire Bible during your year, you can be sure that you will have the plan to read your Bible. For flexibility, you could read the plan in 400 days, and the other two categories, too.

**Memorization Strategy**

**What to Do Each Day**

**Sunday:** Read the week's memory passage with surrounding verses so you can see it in context. Ask the Lord to help you commit the passage to memory, apply it to your life, and use it to bless others.

**Monday:** Read the week's passage (with the references) about ten times. Cover the passage and try to say it aloud (with its references) ten more times, pausing if necessary. Say each memorized passage from previous weeks one time (about with references).

**Tuesday:** Cover the week's passage entirely to say the verse aloud (with its references) ten more times, pausing if necessary. Say each memorized passage from previous weeks one time (about with references).

**Wednesday-Saturday:** Say the week's passage and each memorized passage from previous weeks one time (about with references).

**Other Suggestions**

- Repeat memorized passages once daily for at least 50 days, after that once every week or two.
- Pray daily asking the Lord to help the word remain in you, using it to bless those you meet and minister to others.
- Take advantage of passing "old" verses during the day to call the week's passage(s) to mind.

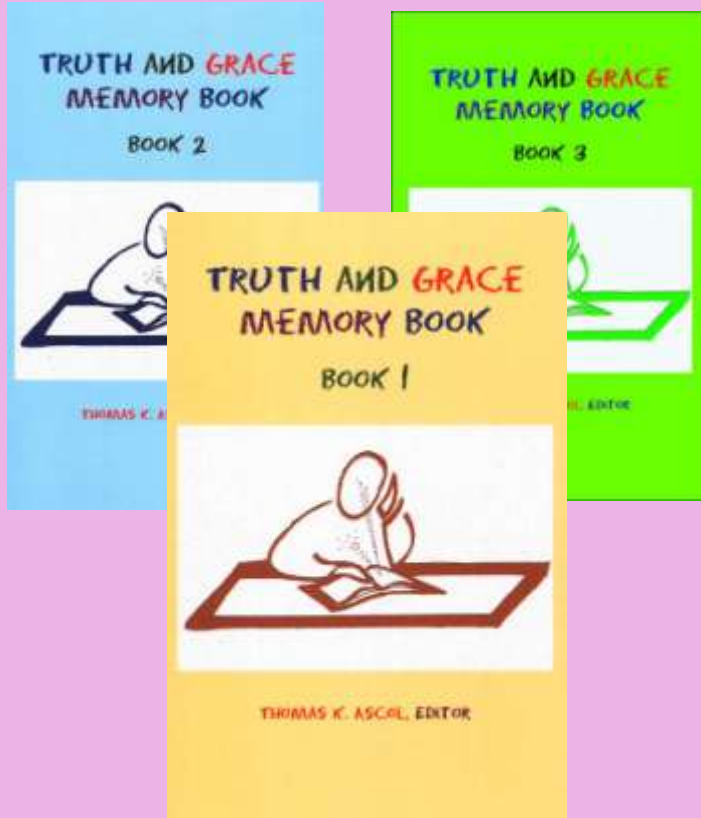

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# How to Teach Bible Verses to Toddlers and Preschoolers

## HOW TO TEACH FIGHTER VERSES TO TODDLERS & PRESCHOOLERS

It is recommended that memory work be done at a separate time from the lesson. It can be done casually merely by periodically repeating the verse during the play. Or, if the children are brought together at an additional time during the hour, the memory verse can be repeated four or five times with the children. (For example, when the children are sitting at the table waiting for snacks, take the opportunity to teach the fighter verse.)

Start by teaching a phrase and then expanding the verse as the children learn its parts. **One verse is focused on each month.**

**The best way to help children memorize verses is repetition.** First, pronounce the reference and have the group repeat it. Then say the verse in several bit size chunks, the children repeat each part. Then say the reference again. Go over the verse several more times, emphasizing the parts said each time.

**Use the Fighter Verse Flash Cards!** The children will quickly associate the shape and color with the verse they are learning. These are particularly helpful for review.

### Ideas for Bible Memory

**Singing:** Put the fighter verse to a traditional tune.

**Tape Recording:** make a tape recording of your class saying their verses. They will love hearing themselves on the recorder!

**Illustrations:** Have each child illustrate the verse or a part of it and display their drawings.

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# Simplify Family Worship

## Simplify Family Worship

A man who is like a spiritual father to me began what he called a "family altar" with his wife before they were married, and has faithfully continued the practice through the arrival of children and grandchildren for more than fifty years. Sadly, it seems that few men among even the best evangelical churches today could speak of daily family worship in their home. In the minds of some, active church involvement eliminates the need for family worship. For others, Bible reading, prayer, and singing proves to God together as a family have been crowded out by the television, the internet, and a non-stop schedule that makes even meals together a rarity.

But the father (and in his absence, the mother) of the family has the responsibility from God to provide spiritual leadership for his household. As He did with Abraham, the Lord wants every father to "command his children and his household after him, that they keep the way of the Lord" (Genesis 18:19). Each one should raise his children "in the training and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). Every husband should love his wife as Christ loves His bride—the church—and follow Christ's example of washing his wife with "the washing of water by the word" of God (Ephesians 5:26).

While it isn't the only way, the simplest method of applying all these texts in a steady, practical way is through daily family worship. This is how generations of Christians have understood them. For instance, both Baptists and Presbyterians in the 1600s saw this biblical teaching, and incorporated identical language about the expectation of family worship into the most influential confessional statements in their respective histories. To this day, many churches still maintain (at least officially) that, "God is to be worshipped everywhere in spirit and truth, as in private families daily."

Somehow, though, many men have gotten the idea that family worship is complicated, or that it requires time-consuming preparation. But it need not require any more preparation than your personal worship of God. And the entire experience can be reduced to these simple elements: read, pray, sing.

**Read.** The centerpiece of family worship is the Bible. Read a passage of appropriate length for your family, making any impromptu comments that come to mind. Those with younger children should emphasize the narrative portions of Scripture, and possibly the Proverbs. Eventually, most seem to work up to about a chapter a day, reading consecutively through a particular book of the Bible. I recommend that you ask a few questions to determine comprehension, or just ask the children to repeat what they remember.

**Pray.** Let the words of the passage you read suggest matter for prayer. The husband/father should pray, and perhaps one or all the rest of the family members. Most days this will be brief.

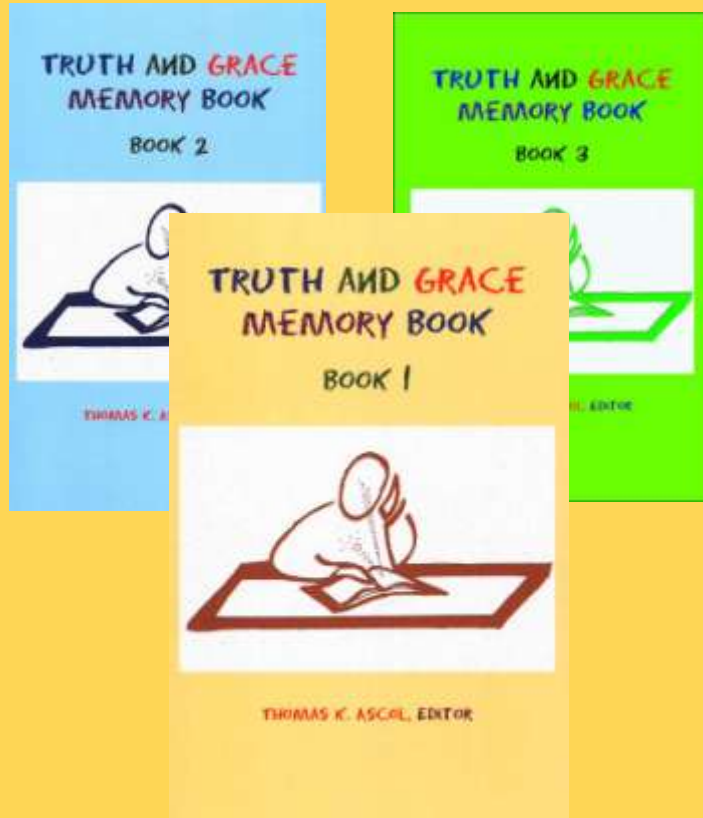
**Sing.** Use a hymnal and sing a cappella, or sing along to a recording, or let a family musician lead the way. Sing as little as one verse, or for as long as the family enjoys it.
