

RBC MINISTRY TEAM DESCRIPTIONS

MEMBERSHIP MATTERS

- Work with the appropriate Sunday School class and/or community group to provide wedding and baby showers as needed
- Provide meals and other ministry to families during the loss of an immediate family member: parent, spouse, children, and minor sibling.
- Work with the pastor to arrange for baptisms.
- Help to ensure that new members are assimilated into the life of the church.
- Sunday Welcome Basket visits. New visitors who fill out a yellow visitor's card receive a brief "at the door" thank you visit on Sunday afternoon (or as early the next week as possible), complete with a welcome basket with literature and gifts.

BENEVOLENCE, MATERIAL AND PHYSICAL NEEDS

- Provide assistance for temporal physical needs, such as lawn mowing, leaf raking, snow removal, minor home repairs, etc. to members in need.
- Provide temporary family care for members in crisis situations, including but not limited to babysitting, elder care, etc.

HOSPITAL, HOMEBOUND, AND HOSPICE VISITATION

- Personal contact to a hospitalized or homebound member for encouragement, prayer, and spiritual blessing.
- Work with the Membership Matters team to help provide follow-up care in the event of the death of a family member.
- Devotional material or other appropriate biblical literature may be taken, but a **short** friendly visit and time of prayer is the focus.
