2. What attribute (trait/characteristic) of God does the author emphasize in Chapter 1? How does this attribute give you hope as one who does/will give devotional talks? What personal responsibility results for you (and any other teacher of Scripture) from this attribute of God?
3. On pages 20-22, the author indicates that God uses Scripture to accomplish at least two things. What are these two things?
4. According to the author, what three things hinder people from hearing God's Word? Over which one(s) of these three hindrances do you, as a speaker, have control?
5. On pages 26-27, the author indicates that the Holy Spirit works in at least two ways in the process of biblical teaching/preaching. What are these two ways?
